We host various service organizations (Red Cross Blood Drive, Lions Club, etc.) and welcome members of the community as guests in our restaurant. We are proud to provide a safe and secure place for people to gather. In light of the recent events concerning COVID-19, the Legion is following the protocols recommended by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and local health officials. Our custodial staff conducts a daily “wipe-down” of surfaces with industrial-strength disinfectant. We have installed hand sanitizer dispensers at entrances to the Post. Our rest room facilities provide soap and water for frequent hand washing.

If you visit our Post we urge you to use common sense and follow the advice of health care professionals. Wash you hands frequently. Cover your nose and mouth if you sneeze or cough. Minimize physical contact like shaking hands or embracing. If you do not feel well, please stay home and seek medical advice. For those who rely on the restaurant for their principal meals and want to minimize contact with other patrons, we are offering an enhanced “take out” option.
