Any member or guest that enters the hall whether vacant or rented will be asked to leave the Post. If the hall is not in use, do NOT cut through the hall to go to the back bar.
2. If the Post is not open, please do not enter areas that are being cleaned by the staff. As the floors will be wet and areas are slippery. If I'm not in the office, please leave a note and do not walk around Post Home. The bar and kitchen areas are off limits when the Post is closed.
3. Do not enter the kitchen when visiting the Post. Our insurance provider has asked that we keep others out of the kitchen except for employees and those that are volunteering during a function.
4. Offensive language or behavior will not be tolerated. Please treat and respect others as you would want them to treat and respect you.
5. If you have any problems with the employees of this Post, they need to be addressed by the Manager first and preferably in writing listing any witnesses.
6. When flowers or centerpieces are on display we ask that they remain in place, please do not remove them the Post.
